













INSTRUMENTATION: EASY-TO-OPEN Angulate ball from the gingival Support the tooth from incisal and press Clip slides OPEN


Full Technique with Nola Retractor and Bracketing

BONDING UPDATES









4. Use auxiliary appliances [tongue loops, tongue tamers, TPA, RPE]




SEVERAL EXCELLENT CHOICES:

CORRECT CHOICES:

- Use same side canine flipped upside down [remove hook]

Good crown adaptation, increased root torque [+7]
- Use opposite side lower 2nd premolar flipped upside down [remove hook]

Good crown adaptation, increased root torque [+17]






SUPERIMPOSITION OF MOVEMENT Widen buccal corridors Advance lower incisors BLUE IS FINAL

Doctor starts IPR with metal polishing strips
Every case is different
Sometimes we start on the initial visit...ALL PLANNED IN CLINCHECK

CLASS III: INVISALIGN correction with IPR [in the lower arch]








Class III with prognathic mandible, mild maxillary retrognathia, poor upper alignment, complete anterior crossbite

Refinement stage.....bite closure almost ideal









INTERDISCIPLINARY TX: Create ideal spacing for canine implant.

INTERDISCIPLINARY TX: create ideal spacing for canine implant













FRONTAL VIEW: eliminated lower crowding, corrected Class III, provided space for ideal OB/OJ

MISSING UPPER RT CENTRAL INCISOR & now requires extraction of other central incisor: will requires implants and transitional restorations

Treatment Progress: frontal view

Agenesis of both upper lateral incisors with considerable movement required


